Agenda Items

1) Design Standards Update (MoDOT)

MoDOT will no longer subcontractor insurance, however, a list of approved subcontractors will still be maintained.

June 19th added as new official State holiday, but is not considered a major holiday for project work restrictions.

Sec 109.14 clarified to preclude fuel adjustments for JOC work.

Sec 206.4.14 created to define expectations for culvert cleanout.

Sec 413.10.5.1 revised testing requirements for micro-surfacing agg.

JSP-02-06 for WZ traffic management revised.

Training provision in the General Provisions has been updated.

E-Construction has been updated to allow electronic notarizations.

SD 620.00 Sheet 3 has been revised to show centerline stripes on inside of longitudinal construction joint, rather than outside.

2) AC Index on Seal Coat, UBAW's and Underseal (MAPA)

MAPA members want existing AC indices for maintenance treatments kept in place. MoDOT will maintain the current indices.

MoDOT routinely puts AC and fuel index options in every contract, even if the contract pay items do not qualify for either or both. This has created some confusion for contractors. MoDOT will try to be more clear about eligibility.

3) MoDOT's Balanced Lettings (MAPA)

MoDOT would like a more consistent distribution of asphalt paving projects over the course of the year to create efficiencies in allocation of resources, such as quarries being able to crush and stockpile enough aggregate. The MoDOT Design Division will put together a task group to address this issue and get feedback from the industry.

4) Status of Annual District Project Meetings (MAPA)

SW District has held these meetings for several years. NW District has an inaugural meeting tentatively scheduled for March 3rd.
