



Quality in Construction Paving Awards Program

The Missouri Asphalt Pavement Association is proud to recognize quality asphalt projects completed throughout the state of Missouri. Awards will be given to winners and runners-up of outstanding projects in a total of nine categories. Project contractors, owners, and engineers will receive recognition for the effort required to produce such high quality work.

All projects submitted to the Paving Awards program must have been completed in the past 12 months except for the Longevity Award. Submissions will be judged on the following criteria: smoothness, longitudinal joints, segregation, degree of difficulty, innovative practices, uniqueness of the project, and overall quality. <p>Full Depth Paving</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New construction and/or reconstruction involving placement of Full Depth Asphalt/WMA. 	<p>Overlay Minor Road (Non-super pave)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non super pave mix involving placement of HMA or WMA over an existing road. • May include widening. 	<p>Municipal Paving</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full depth, new construction, or reconstruction of city streets. • Hot mix paving and/or warm mix paving.
<p>Private & Commercial Paving (New Construction)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes parking lots, private driveways or access roads, cart/walking trails, and/or other privately owned asphalt pavement. • Hot mix asphalt and/or warm mix asphalt paving. 	<p>Private & Commercial Paving (Reconstruction or Maintenance)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes parking lots, private driveways or access roads, cart/walking trails, and/or any other privately owned asphalt pavement. • Hot mix asphalt, warm mix asphalt, and/or any type of chip seal, slurry, microsurfacing, or other type of surface treatment. 	<p>Airport Paving</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes all types of hot mix and/or warm mix paving.
<p>Primary Route (less than 50,000 tons)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asphalt paving less than 50,000 tons. • Can include widening, overlay, full depth paving, new construction, or reconstruction. 	<p>Primary Route (greater than 50,000 tons)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asphalt paving greater than 50,000 tons. • Can include widening, overlay, full depth paving, new construction, or reconstruction. 	<p>Maintenance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application of surface treatments for pavement preservation. • Includes all types of chip seal, slurry, microsurfacing, et cetera. • Cannot include asphalt overlays or asphalt paving other than a leveling course.
<p>Longevity</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognizing quality HMA pavements 10 years or older. • These pavements cannot have received any surface treatments or overlays since construction.
